In this role, she will be responsible for expanding awareness of our mission, solidifying financial stability, adding corporate and community partners, increasing volunteer involvement and growing our Dallas presence.

Andrea honed her marketing and business development skills at Pacheco Koch Consulting Engineers in Dallas. While there, she participated in The Real Estate Council's Associate Leadership Program coordinating the renovation of the Oak Cliff Girls' Inc facility. Andrea served as the Community Liaison at Hamilton Park Pacesetter Magnet where she was responsible for maintaining corporate sponsorships and finding local funding, in addition to working with the historic Hamilton Park community, Richardson ISD, Dallas County and the City of Dallas. She currently serves as a Court Appointed Special Advocate with Lone Star CASA helping children in Rockwall and Kaufman Counties.

When asked why One Man's Treasure? Andrea said: "OMT resonates with me because one of my family members went to prison in 2019. Although we were there to support him, the vast majority of his fellow inmates didn't have anyone. He would ask us to send commissary money, pay for phone time and help his fellow inmates in various ways. One Man's Treasure offers hope and resources for men who don't know what's next. No matter the reason they were there, we see them as people without judgment, giving them the confidence to attend that interview or first day of work knowing they look good and that someone is rooting for them."

The Board of Directors has been searching for a transformational leader who can help take One Man's Treasure to the next level of service and impact. Our mission remains clear: to ensure that

every man seeking a fresh start has access to the clothing, resources, and encouragement needed to rebuild his life with dignity and confidence.

Andrea's proven ability to lead organizations, inspire teams, and achieve meaningful results makes her the clear choice.

"The Board was energized from the moment we met Andrea," said Tom Dooley, Board President. "Her passion for the mission, strategic mindset, and ability to get things done set her apart. We are confident that Andrea will help One Man's Treasure expand its impact and serve more men than ever before.
